Description

In Brief This delightful dry rose is made from the French Syrah variety planted to the coolest part of the Estate's vineyard, which is exclusively reserved for the making of rose wine.

Tasting notes On the nose, the wine is slightly spicy and entices with intense aromas of summer fruits, particularly strawberry, cherry and blueberry. It has a refreshing acidity combined with fruity character that gives an opulently textured mouthfeel and a lively finish.

Food Pairing It is a fabulous partner to a variety of dishes such as shellfish and shrimp, seafood pastas, sautéed vegetables and cold cuts.
