Vinification	Traditional vinification for reds with fermentation at 28°C and maceration for about two weeks, followed by full malolactic fermentation.
Ageing	14 months in 225 liter French oak barrels (30% new, 70% second and third use).

Description

In Brief	The name of this wine is tied to the history of the Tasca family. A tribute to Richard Wagner, who in 1881 finished the third act of "Parsifal" in the gardens of Villa Tasca, inspired by the swans (cigno) that lived on the lake. A selection of Nero d'Avola, cultivated on the high hills, and Cabernet Sauvignon blended to fully express the potential, elegance and austerity of the Sicilian grape varieties.
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Tasting notes	On the nose: ripe red fruits - cherry and strawberry with a hint of vanilla, spices and smoke. Great structure and texture of the tannins. A warm, long finish.
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Food Pairing	Excellent for steak, burgers or barbeque.
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
