Vinification	After harvest the grapes were quickly crushed and pressed into stainless steel tanks where the juice was fermented at controlled cool temperatures to capture the intense varietal flavours. The wine was then blended and bottled.

In Brief	Like the uncurling Koru design on the label (the fern frond shape of the Koru is a symbol of creation), perpetually growing yet always curving back towards its source, Rongopai Wines look both forwards and back. As one of New Zealand's oldest wine brands, owned by Babich, standing for creativity and consistency since 1932, the Rongopai story is one of passion, innovation and excellence.
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Tasting notes	Embraces aromatically with a soft smoky perfume and a touch of mandarin. Finely textured and generous palate with a crisp finish. Flavours of citrus, melon and a touch of sweet garden herbs.
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Food Pairing	It works well with a white meat dish. Great with oysters or a green salad.
