Vinification	The grapes are picked and selected by hand from 30-year-old, strongly reduced vineyards. Cold maceration at low temperatures for a period of 15 days. Fermentation with partial carbonic maceration. Long post maceration at high temperatures.
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Ageing	The wine matures for 7 months in new French oak barrels of 225 litres. The wine ages additional 3 years in bottle before being released on to the market.
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Description

In Brief	A unique Cabernet Sauvignon by Santa Sarah, produced solely in one exceptional vintage.
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Santa Sara Wine Estate is one of the oldest wineries in the modern Bulgarian wine history. The aim of its creator has always been high-quality wines that speak for themselves. Nowadays the vineyards and the winery are located in the village of Goritsa, not far from Pomorie.

Tasting notes	Deep, intense ruby colour. The nose is complex and layered with hints of mint liqueur, cocoa, dried meat with paprika and earthy nuances. Tight body with great concentration, mature, velvety tannins and liqueur-ink finish with noble mineral accents in the aftertaste.
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Food Pairing	Pairs well with cured red meats, game dishes, spicy cheeses.
