Vinification The grapes are sourced from hilly terrains. They are then pressed, followed by 10 days of fermentation at 16–19°C.

Ageing Stored in stainless steel tanks for 3–6 months before bottling.

Description

In Brief This Tini Sauvignon Blanc is produced from grapes grown on calcareous and clay soils at elevations of 100–550 m.a.s.l.,

Tasting notes Straw yellow with a delicate greenish hue. Fresh acidity with a lovely spectrum of varietal aromas – grapefruit citrus, ripe tropical fruit, and delicate floral-herbal notes. On the palate: lean, crisp and fresh, with a full body and confidently aromatic character.

Food Pairing Extremely versatile at the table – pairs beautifully with creamy pastas and risottos, fish-based dishes, soft and creamy cheeses, and seafood.
