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Description

In Brief	Unlike other wine regions of Italy, Friuli is known for growing both local grape varieties - T-Friulano, Ribolla Gialla, and international ones such as Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. Collio, a Friuli DOC subregion, is one of the world's most famous regions for high-quality white wines, thanks to its unique terroir.
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Tasting notes	Straw yellow with greenish highlights when young. A penetrating fragrance of spring flowers introduces the distinct note of almonds typical of the variety, which is echoed on the dry, full-bodied palate with its rounded flavour and long aromatic length.
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Food Pairing	A classic aperitif that can also be served with fish or asparagus-based starters, spring soups and pasta or rice in fish sauces.
