Vinification

The beginning of the grape harvest is postponed until the moment when there is a partial wilting of the grains. In this way, a better concentration of aromas and easier extraction of the body and colour from the grape skins are obtained. The individual fermenters are subjected to different fermentation regimes. Malolactic fermentation takes place in the barrels. Combining different techniques for vinification and ageing in a balanced way enriches the complexity of the wine.

In French oak barrels for 7-8 months.

One of the oldest wine brands in Bulgaria, which has kept its name to this day, UNIQATO preserves the authenticity of local grape varieties and the power of the elements.

Tasting notes

Wine with a deep ruby color and aromas of red fruit. It has a full body with tight tannins, which become smoother quickly in the ageing process. One can also find smoky-earthy notes, floral-herbal perfume, and often jam-like sweetness. A wine with a long finish and ageing potential.
